

VERTIGO PIANO



When we met the architects in charge of this project we had no idea that this particular piano would be customised to this extent before taking up residence on a magnificent yacht.

We worked in confidence with the project leaders responsible for the interior design of the Yacht Vertigo: defining the format and technical characteristics of the piano, researching materials, felt, varnish shades and finding a technical solution for fixing the legs securely to the yacht floor – all in response the end-customer's exacting requirements.

From our initial meeting with the architects-interior designers right up to delivery of the piano on the prestigious yacht in Holland this project garnered all the dynamism of the team at Pianos Hanlet. Our technicians should be proud of this very elegant end-result: a midnight blue piano with a grey aluminium iron-cast plate and chrome metal accents – a real work of art!

MODEL: M-170 (length 170 cm) - second-life.

Project completed within 12 weeks.

PIANO RENOVATION IN WORKSHOP:

Varnishing of interior plating with Grey Aluminium. New strings and new set of chrome tuning pins. Revarnishing of soundboard. Original red felt replaced by black felt.

PIANO CASE FINISHING DETAILS:

Revarnished case and inner section of rim with midnight blue gloss. Plates entirely revamped with fresh nickel. Revarnished lid prop, fall and leg struts with matt blue.

FIXINGS:

Custom creation of fixing system to secure 3 legs of piano to floor of boat (instead of usual wheels): development of a specific matrix that respects the manufacturer's design. New nickel plating for framework of fixings.



Complete review and touch optimisation. Preparation, tuning and musical harmonisation.
